WALKING PATH
A well marked walking path from Medal Plaza and the City Fest up to the Biathlon Arena. About 2 km long.

BUS SHUTTLE
From the Town Square up to the Arena and back to the City Fest after the race, you can ride for free with our electronic buses, nr 14, when showing your WCH-ticket for that day. The Biathlon bus will run continuously starting 2 hours before the competition and 1 hour after.

CITY MINI TRAIN (9/3-17/3)
From the upper part of the Town Square, where the City Fest takes place, you can get on the SJ Mini Train that for free will take you up to the Biathlon Arena or back down to the City Fest after the competitions. The Train will operate each competition day starting March 9th and operate with stops at the Town Square, Fältjägargränd and the Biathlon Arena.

BUS STATION
Take the bus back to your accommodation from the bus station in Östersund Centrum. This is the hub both for the city buses and the regional buses and the waiting hall is open most part of the day and evening. A helpdesk will be open weekdays 10 am to 4 pm. Search your trip, find timetables, stops and fees at www.ltr.se or download their app "Lanstrafiken Jamtland". Accepted payments: VISA and Mastercard. Please note that cash payment is not accepted. You can also buy your ticket in the app.

PERMANENTLY CLOSED ROADS
Rådhusgatan between Biblioteksgatan and Hamngatan/Bus station and a part of Postgränd will be permanently closed from 1 March 9 pm to 17 March 9 pm. Litsvägen will be closed for all traffic from the roundabout Litsvägen - Arenavägen (at Östersund Arena) and the roundabout Litsvägen - Pampasvägen - Genvägen between 2-18 March.

TEMPORARY CLOSED ROADS
Ceremony evenings between 6 pm and 10 pm following dates; 6-10 March, 12-14 March and 16 March, the closed area will also cover Rådhusgatan from Samuel Permans Gata to Hamngatan. As well as Biblioteksgatan from Södra Gröngatan to the Tourist Office.
